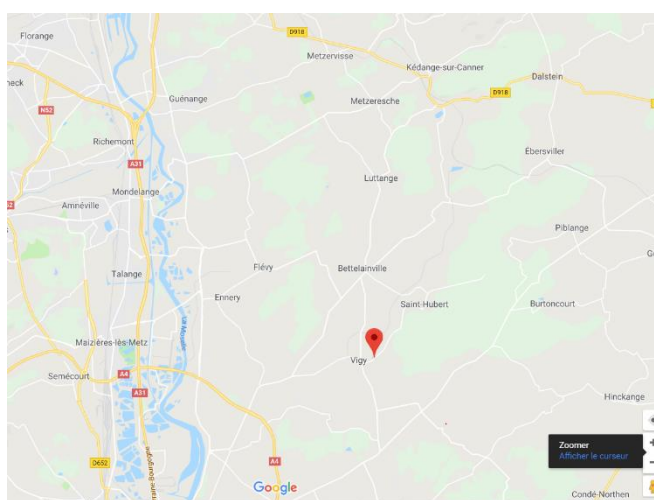

- ✓ The 3 best scores count.
- ✓ The 5th gymnast can pass on the 6 apparatus but the 4 gymnasts selected for the apparatus for the team must be identified on the sheet of match.

However, each team, can present a 6th additional gymnast who will be out of team ranking. This gymnast will always pass in last position.
